
The Center is built on a main exhibition based on a timeline connecting the history and the future.

Below is presented the six most important thematic industrial areas in West Sweden:

- Textile industry
- Shipbuilding
- Vehicle industry
- Mechanical industry
- Power production
- Trade/shipping

Maybe the most important is No. seven:

• The Industry today and in the future



- The Centre will consist of an industry historical exhibition following a timeline ending in the future, with generous areas for temporary exhibitions.
- Furthermore, a large general area with reception, shop, cafe and restaurant, an auditorium, library, class/meeting rooms, try-out area for children and young people, as well as information about all 150 workplace museums in the Western Götaland region.
- The Centre should be open all week, incl. Saturday and Sunday, have easy access via general communications and have large parking areas.
- In our vision we see a center with a clear architectural profile, a building with a spectacular appearance connected to the historical and the future identity of the industrial region of Western Sweden.



Take care of the history and let it point out the future direction!

- The industry of West Sweden has been and still is the motor in the development of Gothenburg City and the region for hundreds of years.
- Gothenburg is the hub of the most important industrial region in Northern Europe and it stands for a fantastic industrial heritage.
- The development is progressing in an increasing pace and the industrial soul is still there.
- It is urgent to take care and make use of our industrial heritage before it is too late – those who created and knew the history are fewer for every year.
- We lack an industrial center a timeline which describes the industrial history of the Western region of Sweden and the city of Gothenburg – that leads us into the future!
